

There are so many local opportunities for quilting fun coming up this year – our show, speaker workshops and service projects, just to name a few. I've started my resolutions for 2015, with the serious intention of following through with them. So far I've resolved to 1) take more quilting classes, 2) go to more quilt shows, 3) go on monthly Fabric Acquisition Road Trips to new quilt shops. (If anyone is interested in joining me on a road trip, let me know.) I've even tempered my resolution to exercise more often with the promise of a good book that I will only read when on the treadmill. Who ever said that resolutions had to be painful?

One of the things I like best about the holiday season is hearing from old friends. A note from my college roommate reminded me that I graduated from college 50 years ago in January. I guess I'll go to my class reunion this year for the first time in many years. Hopefully there will be some good quilt shops along the way to help me keep my New Year's resolutions.

For the next three weeks, my focus is on sewing together the first 80 blocks for the Jacobean

embroidery project that I have been working on since August. (Work on the next 88 blocks for the border starts in mid-January.) The blocks have to be carefully aligned, so I'm getting really good at unsewing. If you notice that I have some bald spots, it may be from where I have pulled my hair out in frustration. I'm glad our show is this year, because otherwise this might become a UFO. However, I'm determined to get it done in time for the show, so I'll do a little every day from now until then. After all, no matter how frustrating a quilting project is, it still beats housework. If I had any doubts about how well I'd like the finished quilt, I might consider abandoning the project (I've been known to put multiple blocks in the trash bin), but I love the sample in the shop and the pictures online, so I'm going to finish it. Please help me keep focused by occasionally asking how many blocks I have completed. You probably noticed that I don't have a resolution to finish everything, so I'll need support from all of you to get this done in time for the show.

I hope to see everyone at the January meeting. Until then, happy quilting.

We all know that quilters are a generous bunch! Here’s a great way you can use your time and talents to benefit those who would truly appreciate some extra warmth and comfort. Take part in the Service Projects Challenge for the 2015 FSQ Quilt Show! Make a quilt that will hang in the show but will then be donated either to Fisher House at the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center in Bethesda **OR** to the Betty Ann Krahnke Center in Montgomery County, our two charities this year for the show.

Our theme is “The Sky’s the Limit” so all we’re requiring is that your quilt have some recognizable piece of blue and white incorporated somewhere in the top. The size can be anywhere from 36” x 36” inches for a baby up to twin-size, since both of these charities serve all age ranges. Register your quilt and drop it off on the regular quilt drop-off day and we will take it from there. You won’t receive your quilt back at the end of the show; we will gather them all up and take care of delivering them. For more information, go to
