September 12, 2016 Guild Meeting:



FSQ Summer Black and White Challenge

I hope that many of you have been working on our Black & White challenge quilts. I know that a lot of the black and white fabric from Services has been taken, so we're expecting a lot of finished quilts to be on display during the September meeting. According to the rules you may use one or many colors for the "splash" of color, but the final quilt should be recognized as a black and white quilt.

The quilt size should be a minimum of 36" square, up to a twin size quilt. All quilts should be quilted and bound. The members will vote at the break, deciding which quilt makes best use of the B&W and color. Winners receive Yard Sale bucks, and all quilts will be donated to Service Projects.
