Service Projects Update

As we reach the end of this quilting year for FSQ, the Service Projects committee is proud to report on numbers of items **completed** and **donated**! With the support of many members of the guild, we made **447 quilts** (both children's and adult), **396 preemie quilts**, **93 preemie hats**, and **221 pillowcases**. What a tremendous effort on the part of many to bring warmth and comfort to the area's residents who need a little extra kindness. Your support is truly appreciated. Many of you completed a quilt top from one of the 164 kits that were given out, or completed a preemie quilt for babies at Holy Cross. Many thanks! Currently, the Guild needs someone to find and coordinate volunteers to white gloving at the Mancuso show in September. We need 32 hours of volunteer (not by one or two people, obviously) so the Guild can display and sell tickets for our 2017 raffle quilt. The Guild also needs someone to handle the raffle quilt marketing. Since we only hold quilt show every other year, this means volunteers going to other guilds and other marketing opportunities.

Generally, we announce volunteer opportunities via email blast and/or at the meeting. If you are not on the blast email list, please contact our membership person Barbara Skelly for info.

We also have quilting opportunities with our service projects. Since most of those are held during work hours, maybe talking with our service project people about possible weekend or evening gathering would work. One could also start a small quilt group of those who have challenging work schedules.
